


# INSTRUCTION MANUAL KHAKI NAVY SCUBA GMT

Hamilton is delighted that you have chosen a timepiece from its collection. You have acquired a small technological marvel that will serve you faithfully for many years. The most advanced techniques were used throughout its manufacture, and it underwent strict controls before it was released for sale.

Equipped with an automatic GMT movement, your Hamilton Khaki Navy Scuba GMT watch indicates a second time zone thanks to its 24-hour hand and the 24-hour display on the bezel.



#### DISPLAY

- 1 Hour hand (local time)
- 24-hour GMT hand (reference time)
- 3 Minute hand
- 4 Seconds hand
- **5** Date
- 6 24-hour rotating bezel
- **C** Crown

#### **CROWN POSITIONS**

**p0**: Crown screwed down

p1: Manual winding (crown unscrewed)

**p2**: Setting of the local time and correction of the date

p3: Setting of the reference time (24-hour hand) and the minutes

N.B.: in position p3, the seconds hand stops.

## SETTINGS

Please follow the steps below to firstly set the reference time (24-hour) and the minutes, followed by the date and the local time (12-hour).

- 1. Unscrew the crown and pull it out to position p3.
- 2. Set the reference time using the 24-hour hand (read on the 24-hour rotating bezel) and the minute hand (read on the dial) by turning the crown in the applicable direction. The hour hand (local time) will move simultaneously. Ensure that the zero point (triangle) on the bezel is correctly positioned at 12 o'clock. If this is not the case, refer to the instructions on page 2.
- 3. To set the date and the local time, place the crown in position p2, and turn it in the applicable direction. The date changes each time the hour hand passes midnight. The hour hand moves in increments of 1 hour. Ensure the hour hand is correctly positioned to display the time in the morning (midnight to midday) or the afternoon/evening (midday to midnight).
- 4. Push the crown back in and screw it down.

The local time should be identical to the reference time (24-hour hand).

## WHEN TRAVELING

Set the local time for your destination as follows:

- 1. Unscrew the crown and pull it out to position p2.
- 2. Turn the crown in the applicable direction to set the hour hand to the local time, without changing the reference time in 24-hour format.
- 3. Push the crown back in and screw it down.



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If the zero point (triangle) on the bezel has moved: Turn the bezel counter-clockwise to position the triangle at 12 o'clock.
